Subject: Import of Testing/Prototype sample units of device having Wi-Fi/Bluetooth facility in License Exempt bands.

Sir,


I am directed to invite your kind attention on the subject and to state that Import License for Testing/Prototype sample units of devices such as Mobile Handsets, Notebooks and Laptops alongwith associated peripherals having Wi-Fi/Bluetooth facility in License Exempt bands may be issued without Equipment Type Approval (ETA).

2. After completion of test/prototype exercise, same equipments may be either exported back to the country of origin or destructed as per destruction guidelines of WPC Wing.

3. Further, in case these equipments/devices to be put in use in the country, Equipment Type Approval (ETA) must be obtained from Regional Licensing Offices of Wireless Planning & Coordination (WPC) Wing.

4. The applicant is required to submit an undertaking in the enclosed proforma along with request for import in the prescribed proforma.
